



## **Dress Code**

Within the Madressa, all Students & Teachers must adhere strictly to the dress code, outlined below.

All Students, Parents & Teachers must observe modest dressing at ALL times!

***Note:** Children may need to be outside, therefore please ensure appropriate clothing is worn when needed e.g. jackets. (Please make sure all jackets are labelled with your child's full name)*

### **CLASSES A-C (Under Age 6):**

#### **GIRLS:**

Although girls are not Baligh when they start Class A, we would like to encourage all girls to wear appropriate modest clothing, their arms and legs should be covered, **and they must wear a scarf.**

#### **BOYS:**

Long Pants (NO Shorts) with a T-shirt or Shirt (Preferably Plain with *NO Advertisements or Loud Prints*)

### **CLASSES D & Above: (Ages 7 and up)**

#### **GIRLS:**

- Loose Longs Tops, OR A Closed Abaya/Chaadar and correctly observed Hijab (covering the hair and neck)
- Make-up should not be visible.
- ***Nail varnish should not be worn.***
- Minimal or discrete jewelry – Preferably NO Jewelry.

#### **BOYS:**

- Long Pants, Long-sleeve T-shirt or Shirt (*preferably Plain with NO Advert or LOUD Prints*)
- No shorts, No Jewelry (i.e. earrings) or hats (aside from Muslim prayer hats).
- If wearing tops with print or images, these must not be inappropriate, bearing in mind the sanctity of the Institution.
